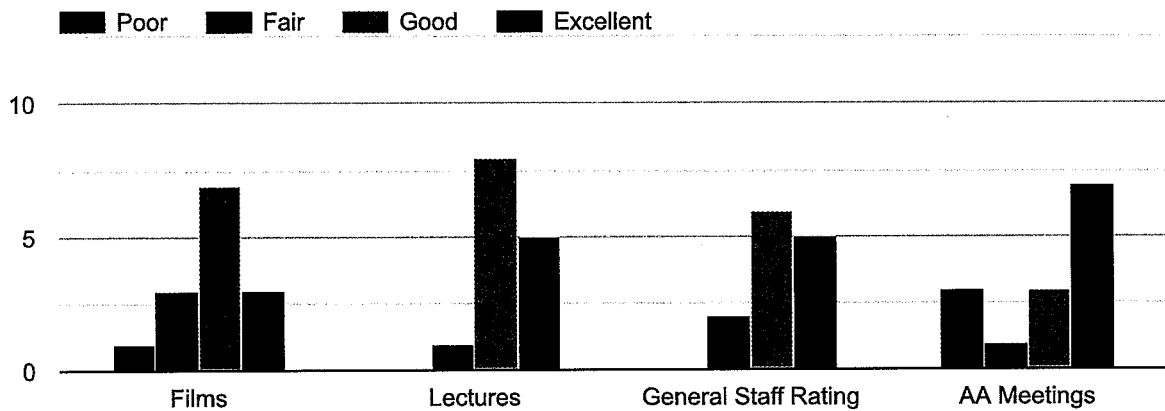

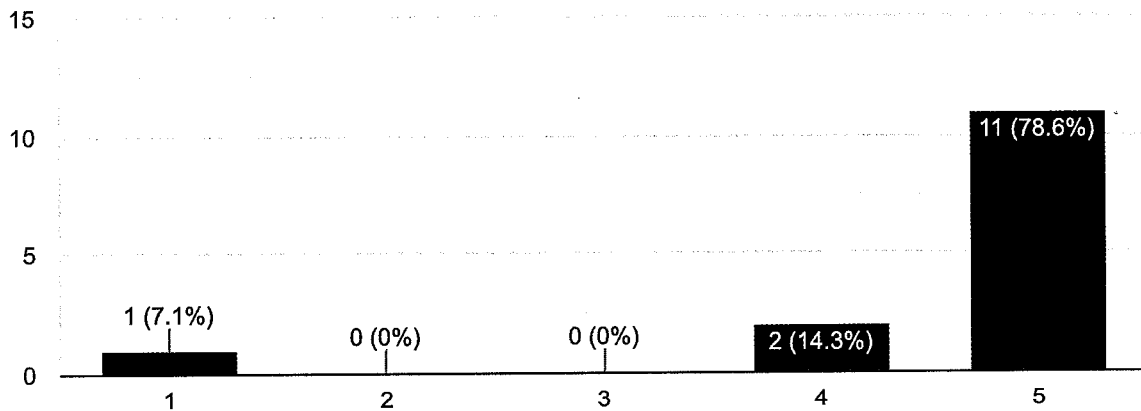

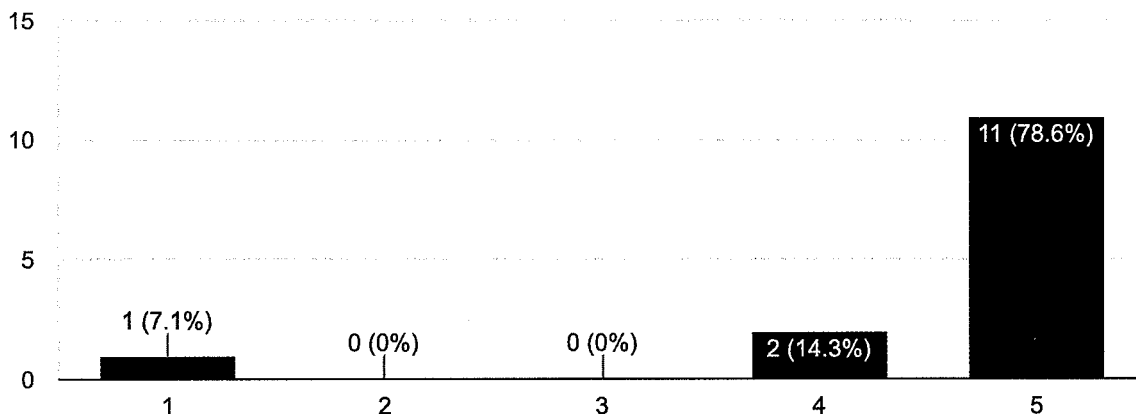
I felt I could approach my counselor with individual problems.

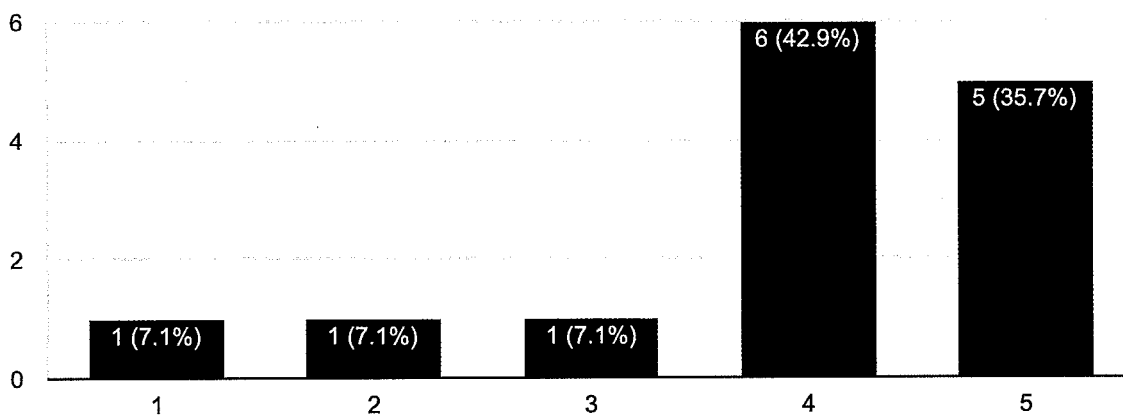

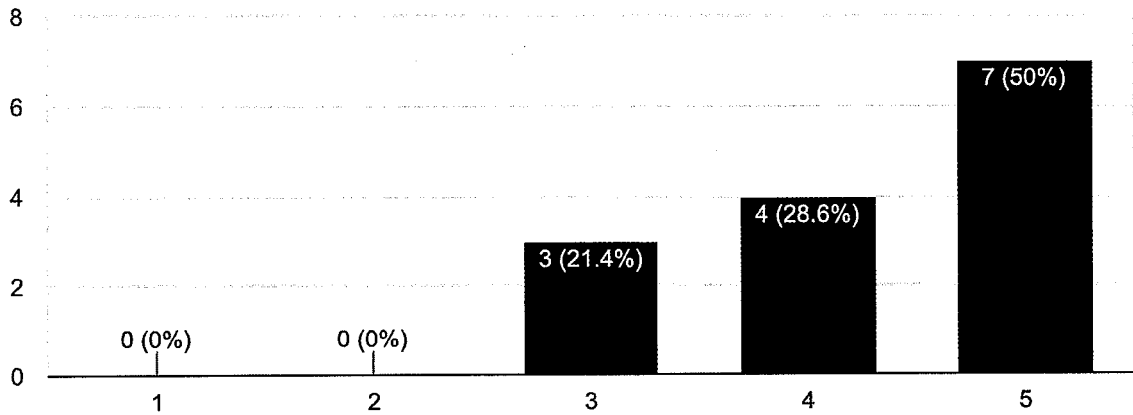
